ORDER

As per the directions in the GO read as 1st paper above, KSIDC completed the tender process for the development of Integrated Solid Waste Management Projects with Waste to Energy Plant at Kanjikkode in Palakkad district. As per the tender conditions, Concession Agreement was executed on 24th August 2020 between LSGD, KSIDC, Participating Local Bodies and Concessionaire M/s Bluè Planet Palakkad Waste Solutions Pvt Ltd. As per the Concession Agreement, following are the Participating Local Bodies (PLBs) in Palakkad cluster.

- (2) As part of preparation of DPR for the project the Concessionaire carried out a detailed waste characterization and quantification study in

the cluster and it was found that the quantity of waste generated in the cluster is far below the minimum quantity to be ensured for the viable operation of the plant. The Concessionaire raised the concern in the meeting of the Technical Committee constituted for the evaluation of draft DPR for waste to energy projects in the state.

- (3) The matter was also reported to the review meeting convened by Chief Principal Secretary to Hon'ble Chief Minister on 22.06.2021 and it was resolved to include Grama Panchayats in the district as additional LSGIs in to the cluster to ensure the minimum guaranteed supply of waste to the plant.
- (4) A stake holders meeting was convened on 19.07.2021 by Principal Secretary, LSGD with 20 Grama Panchayats adjoining to existing Municipalities in the cluster. As per letter read as 2nd paper above MD, KSIDC has reported that based on the discussions and deliberations held in the meeting and the follow ups done by KSIDC, the following Grama Panchayats have obtained Council approval to participate in the project and also to execute the Concession Agreement.

The above said Grama Panchayats have submitted the copy of their Council resolutions to KSIDC for further proceedings in this regard. MD, KSIDC has requested that necessary orders may be issued to execute a Supplementary Concession Agreement between LSGD, KSIDC, Concessionaire and the above Grama Panchayats with same terms and conditions of the approved Concession Agreement for the development of Integrated Solid Waste Management Project with Waste to Energy Plant at Kanjikkode in Palakkad district.

(5) Government have examined the matter in detail and are pleased to include the above 19 Grama Panchayats also as participating LSGs for the development of Integrated Solid Waste Management Project with Waste to Energy Plant at Kanjikkode in Palakkad district and also accord sanction to KSIDC to enter into a Supplementary Concession Agreement with these LSGs, which must be signed by all the parties and should be make part of the Concession Agreement. MD, KSIDC should ensure that, in doing so it is in line with the terms of the tender conditions.
