ORDER

As per GO read as 5th paper above and as per GO read as 6th paper above sanction have been accorded to KSWMP for hiring two electric vehicles from ANERT and accordingly two vehicles are being used by KSWMP.

(2) As per letter read as 7th paper above Project Director, KSWMP reported that these two vehicles are exclusively required for the official use of the Project Director and the Deputy Project Director. There are no otvehicles for the official journeys of the State Project Management Unit (SPMU) staff. As the project has started in full swing, the SPMU staff often have to make recurring journey. As the geographical coverage of the project includes 93 Urban Local bodies, frequent site

inspections and travel across the State is essential and it is informed that one more vehicle is essential for the official journeys of the staff attached to SPMU. Project Director, KSWMP has requested that sanction may be accorded for hiring one e-vehicle from ANERT for office use and also to hire one fuel vehicle on contract basis having cubic capacity below 1500 cc with a seating capacity of not more than 7 persons including driver on need basis for performing site inspections by inviting competitive quotations from interested persons / travel agencies. The expenditure in this regard can be met from the funds available with the Kerala Solid Waste Management Project.

(3) Government have examined the matter in detail and are pleased to accord sanction to hire one non-electric vehicle as per the instructions contained in the Circular read as 2nd paper above and GO read as 1st paper above and to hire one electric vehicle as per the instructions in GO read as 3rd and 4th paper above, for the State Project Management Unit of Kerala Solid Waste Management Project.
