<u>ORDER</u>

An amount of is Rs.8.88 Cr. has been allocated to Erattupetta Municipality for water supply projects. 5th meeting of SHPSC has considered project proposal submitted by Erattupetta Municipality for the Micro Water Supply Scheme with bore wells as sources. As per the minutes read as 1 st paper above, 5 th meeting of SHPSC has directed the Erattupetta municipality to revise the project proposal replacing the bore well sources with other surface water sources. Kerala Water Authority (KWA) has proposed a scheme utilizing common components of the Malankara-based Neelur JJM scheme for meeting the water requirements of Erattupetta Municipality, as there are no other sustainable water resources in that area. The Executive Engineer, KWA Kottayam has submitted an alternate proposal for the Erattupetta Municipality for Rs. 128 Cr. The proposal aims to utilize the already awarded production components of JJM Neeloor, Water Supply to Erattupetta, and WTP.

2. Based on the recommendation of 9 th SLTC meeting of AMRUT, the 6 th SHPSC of AMRUT 2.0 has decided to accord sanction for allocating an additional fund of Rs.11.12 Cr. from the floating fund in addition to the allocated fund of Rs.8.88 Cr. (Total- Rs.20 Cr.) for the water supply scheme for Zone-1 Thevarupara utilizing the already awarded production components of JJM (Neeloor Water Supply scheme).The Committee has also decided to accord administrative sanction for the topographic survey and soil investigation works for an amount of Rs. 19.183 lakhs. 3. As per the letter read as 3 rd paper above, Mission Director, AMRUT has requested accord sanction based on the decisions taken by the SHPSC.

4. Government have examined the mater and are pleased to accord sanction to allocate an additional fund of Rs.11.12 Cr. from the floating fund in addition to the allocated fund of Rs.8.88 Cr. (Total- Rs.20 Cr.) for the water supply scheme for Zone-1 Thevarupara of Erattupetta Municipality utilizing the already awarded production components of JJM (Neeloor Water Supply scheme). Administrative sanction is also accorded for the topographic survey and soil investigation works for an amount of Rs. 19.183 lakhs for preparing the detailed project report of the scheme
