## **ORDER**

As per G.O read as 1<sup>st</sup> paper above, Administrative Sanction has been accorded for an amount of Rs. 1.680 Cr. (CAPEX: Rs. 1.600 Cr. and OPEX: Rs. 0.080 Cr.) for the work AMRUT 2.0: Providing a Hotline from Mangadikkunnu WTP to Wards 23 and 32 of Irinjalakuda Municipality; Strengthening old AC and PVC pipes by replacing them with new PE and PVC pipes and providing 200 numbers of FHTCs. Notice Inviting Tender (NIT) was floated for the work and two bids were received. L1 bidder quoted 10.16% above Tendered Probable Amount of Contract (TPAC-Rs.1,30,53,310/-) and on negotiation L1 bidder reduced the amount to 9.07% above TPAC.

As the revision of Administrative Sanction is required due to the tender excess, as per the minutes read as 3<sup>rd</sup> paper above, 6<sup>th</sup> SHPSC has approved the revision of the Administrative Sanction of the project: "AMRUT 2.0-Providing a hotline from Mangadikkunnu WTP to wards 23 and 32 of Irinjalakuda Municipality; Strengthening old AC and PVC pipes by replacing them with new PE and PVC pipes; and providing 200 numbers of FHTCs from Rs. 1.680 Cr. (CAPEX: Rs. 1.600; OPEX: Rs. 0.080 Cr.) to Rs. 1.805 Cr. (CAPEX: Rs. 1.725; OPEX:Rs.0.080 Cr) due to the tender excess, subject to the condition that the 25% of the excess due to tender variation shall be borne by the ULB and 75% by the State.
- 4. As per the letter read as 3<sup>rd</sup> paper above, Mission Director AMRUT has requested to accord sanction based on the decision of SHPSC.
- 5. Government have examined the matter and are pleased to accord revised Administrative Sanction for an amount of Rs. 1.805 Cr. (CAPEX: Rs. 1.725; OPEX:Rs.0.080 Cr) for the project: "AMRUT 2.0-Providing a hotline from Mangadikkunnu WTP to wards 23 and 32 of Irinjalakuda Municipality; Strengthening old AC and PVC pipes by replacing them with new PE and PVC pipes; and providing 200 numbers of FHTCs, subject to the condition that the 25% of the excess due to tender variation shall be borne by the ULB and 75% by the State.
