ORDER

As per GO read as 1st paper above, Administrative Sanction has been accorded for the following additional works related to the Skywalk under Urban Transport sector of AMRUT in Thrissur Municipal Corporation:

- The supply and installation of lift (for an amount of Rs.1.35 Cr.)
- Installation of solar panel (for an amount of Rs.1 Cr.)

2. State Level High Powered Steering Committee (SHPSC) of AMRUT-1.0 has considered the proposal submitted by Secretary, Thrissur Corporation, for approval of Administrative Sanction for 2 new works related to Skywalk under Urban Transport sector of AMRUT in Thrissur Municipal Corporation: (Supply & Installation of Centralized AC - Rs.1.15 Cr. and Side Covering & False Ceiling Work - Rs.2.5 Cr.), due to the following reasons

- The side covering is required for the safety of the people using the skywalk as well as the people in vehicles passing below it.
- Side covering will avoid the entry of birds & insects and will prevent the inside of the skywalk from getting wet during rainfall.
- When side covering is done it is necessary to ensure proper air circulation inside the skywalk.
- These additional features will help in attracting more people to use the skywalk and it will also encourage people to put up small shops inside the skywalk.
- The ULB is also planning to set up barricades on the median as well as on the sides of the footpath for ensuring the use of skywalk by the pedestrians.
- The Skywalk recently won the HUDCO's award for best practices in the UT sector.
- The required amounts of Rs. 1.15 Cr. and Rs. 2.5 Cr. are proposed to be met from the savings available due to the cancellation of the Water Efficient Thrissur Phase-2

3. As the average footfall on the Skywalk observed by the ULB is nearly 9000 per day, based on the recommendation of 29th SLTC, as per the minutes read as 2nd paper above, 34th SHPSC has approved the issuance of Administrative Sanction for two new works ("Supplying and installing centralized AC for Skywalk" – Rs.1.15 Cr. and "Side covering and false ceiling work of Sky Walk" - Rs.2.50 Cr.) related to Skywalk under Urban Transport Sector of AMRUT in Thhrissur Municipal Corporation, subject to the following conditions:

- The total amount required (Rs.3.65 Cr.) shall be met from the savings available due to the cancellation of the work, "Water Efficient Thrissur Phase-2"
- Any financial implication due to non-completion of the work by Mar-2024 shall be borne by the ULB.

4. As per the letter read as 3rd paper above, Mission Director, AMRUT has requested to accord Administrative Sanction for two new works ("Supplying and installing centralized AC for Skywalk" for an

amount of Rs.1.15 Cr. and “Side covering and false ceiling work of Sky Walk” for an amount of Rs.2.50 Cr.) related to Skywalk under Urban Transport Sector of AMRUT in Thrissur Municipal Corporation, based on the decision of 34th SHPSC

5. Government have examined the matter and are pleased to accord Administrative Sanction for two new works (“Supplying and installing centralized AC for Skywalk” for an amount of Rs.1.15 Cr. and “Side covering and false ceiling work of Sky Walk” for an amount of Rs.2.50 Cr.) related to Skywalk under Urban Transport Sector of AMRUT in Thrissur Municipal Corporation, subject to the following conditions:

- The total amount required (Rs.3.65 Cr.) shall be met from the savings available due to the cancellation of the work, “Water Efficient Thrissur Phase-2”
- Any financial implication due to non-completion of the work by Mar-2024 shall be borne by the ULB.
