## **ORDER**

7 <sup>th</sup> State Level High Powered Steering Committee (SHPSC) of AMRUT-2.0 has considered 5 Water Supply projects of Thiruvalla, Trippunithura, Kattappana Municipalities and Thrissur Muncipal Corporation amounting to Rs.8.1192 Cr. (CAPEX – Rs. 7.4492 Cr. & OPEX – Rs.0.67 Cr.), approved under 1st and 2nd tranche of State Water Action Plan (SWAP) under Atal Mission for Rejuvenation and Urban Transformation-2.0 (AMRUT-2.0), as detailed below

Based on the recommendation of State Level Technical Committee (SLTC) of AMRUT, as per the minutes read as 1 st paper above, 7th SHPSC has decided to accord Administrative Sanction for 4 Water supply projects of Thiruvalla Municipality, Trippunithura Municipality and Thrissur Municipal Corporation amounting to Rs.6.9292 Cr. (CAPEX – Rs. 6.409 Cr. & OPEX – Rs.0.52Cr.), subject to the condition that the Technical Sanction shall be issued by the concerned only after meeting the following conditions:

- i. The necessary clearances from the relevant authorities are obtained. ii. The project includes a 5-year Operation & Maintenance plan and only admissible components as per AMRUT guidelines.
- **iii**. The Central Assistance for urban development projects should not cover the costs of Operation & Maintenance, Supervision charges, or the Value of land/ structures required for the project development. These costs should be borne by the State/ ULB fund if they are unavoidable.

7<sup>th</sup> SHPSC of AMRUT 2.O has also decided to grant provisional approval for the Proposal from Kattappana Municipality amounting to *Rs.1.19 Cr. (CAPEX Rs. 1.04 Cr. & OPEX – Rs. 0.15 Cr.)*, subject to the approval from KIIFB.

- 3. As per the letter read as 2<sup>nd</sup> paper above Mission Director, AMRUT has requested to accord sanction for Water Supply Projects of Thiruvalla, Trippunithura, Kattappana Municipalities and Thrissur Municipal Corporation, approved under 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> tranches of SWAP, AMRUT 2.O based on the decision of 7<sup>th</sup> SHPSC and provisional approval for the porposal from Kattappana amounting to Rs.1.19 Cr.
- 4. Government have examined the matter and are pleased to accord Administrative Sanction for an amount of *Rs.6.9292 Cr. (CAPEX Rs. 6.409 Cr. & OPEX Rs.0.52Cr.)* for **4 Water supply projects** of Thiruvalla Municipality, Trippunithura Municipality and Thrissur Municipal Corporation, approved under State Water Action Plan (SWAP) of Atal Mission for Rejuvenation and Urban Transformation-2.0 (AMRUT-2.0), based on the decision of 7<sup>th</sup> SHPSC, as detailed above, subject to the condition that the Technical Sanction shall be issued by the concerned only after meeting the following conditions:
  - i. The necessary clearances from the relevant authorities are obtained. ii. The project includes a 5-year Operation & Maintenance plan and only admissible components as per AMRUT guidelines.
