## **ORDER**

- 6<sup>th</sup> Apex Committee of AMRUT 2.0 held on January 4, 2023, has approved a special State Water Action Plan (SWAP) of 255 projects for the rejuvenation of water bodies worth Rs. 82.354 crore (CA-Rs. 34.02 crore). Based on the decision of 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> State Level High Powered Steering Committee (SHPSC), as per G.Os read as 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> paper above, Administrative Sanction have been accorded for a total amount of Rs.69.315 Cr. for 229 Water Body Rejuvenation projects under AMRUT 2.0. Based on the decision of 7<sup>th</sup> SHPSC as per G.O read as 3<sup>rd</sup> paper above, Administrative Sanction has been accorded for the project "Rejuvenation of Koyappal Pond" of Panoor Municipality for Rs. 0.41 Cr (CAPEX: Rs. 0.40 Cr, O&M: Rs. 0.01 Cr).
- 2. The 8<sup>th</sup> SHPSC of AMRUT 2.0 has considered 4 projects for Water Body Rejuvenation amounting to Rs.1.4 Cr submitted by 3 ULBs (Kanhangad, Eloor & Iritty) from the remaining approved fund in SWAP 1&2. As per the minutes read as 4<sup>th</sup> paper above, 8<sup>th</sup> SHPSC has decided to accord Administrative Sanction for the 4 projects of Kanhangad, Eloor & Iritty

Municipalities, amounting to Rs. **1.4 crore** (CAPEX –1.3144 Cr. & OPEX - Rs. 0.0856Cr), for Rejuvenation of Water Bodies under AMRUT 2.O, subject to the condition that the ULBs shall obtain the consent and undertaking from the owners of the ponds.

- 3. 8<sup>th</sup> SHPSC of AMRUT 2.0 has also considered the matter of cancellation and replacement of projects for Water body Rejuvenation under AMRUT 2.0 and as per the minutes read as 5<sup>th</sup> paper above decided to accord sanction for the cancellation of 22 projects for Rs. 10.914 crore (Capex Rs. 10.34 crore & O&M Rs. 0.574 crore) which cannot be implemented due to various reasons and replacement with 18 projects for Rs. 9.834 crore (Capex Rs. 9.404 crore and O&M Rs. 0.430 crore)
- 4. As per the letter read as 6 <sup>th</sup> paper above, Mission Director, AMRUT has reported that SHPSC accorded the cancellation of 22 projects under Rejuvenation of Water bodies from the approved SWAP 2. Of which, Administration Sanctions were accorded only for the 4 projects of Kollam, Manjeri, Thiruvalla, Muvattupuzha Urban Local Bodies. Mission Director AMRUT has requested to accord sanction for cancellation of 4 projects of above mentioned ULBs
- 5. Government have examined the matter and are pleased to accord Administrative Sanction for the following 4 projects under Rejuvenation of Water Bodies amounting to **Rs. 1.4 crore** (CAPEX –1.3144 Cr. & OPEX Rs. 0.0856Cr) subject to the condition that the ULBs shall obtain the consent and undertaking from the owners of the ponds.
