Minutes of 55th Technical Committee meeting for the 5 evaluation of proposals from startups to Government departments

#### **ORDER**

In furtherance of the goals of the Malinyamuktam Navakeralam campaign, it was resolved to procure and deploy the following digital solutions to strengthen the state's waste management efforts.

- 1. An application for real-time tracking of waste collection and transportation vehicles.
- 2. An application for monitoring surveillance cameras installed at Garbage Vulnerable Points (GVPs), Material Collection Facilities (MCFs), Resource Recovery Facilities (RRFs), etc.

As per Government Order read as 2<sup>nd</sup> paper above, government departments and agencies are authorized to directly purchase products and services from startups registered under the Kerala Startup Mission (KSUM) and possessing a KSUM Unique ID, up to a limit of Rs. 50 lakhs. For procurements exceeding Rs. 50 lakhs but not exceeding Rs. 300 lakhs, a limited tender process may be followed. A procurement

committee was constituted vide Government Order read as 3<sup>r d</sup> paper above to conduct the limited tender process for the procurement of the aforementioned applications. Vide Government Order read as 4<sup>th</sup> paper above, Suchitwa Mission was authorized to finance the procurement of the applications from the Suchitwa Keralam (Rural and Urban) funds.

Following comprehensive technical and financial evaluations of proposals submitted by KSUM-registered startups for the development of the aforementioned applications, the Procurement Committee has identified M/s TeamStarbase Pvt Ltd as having emerged as Rank 1 in the development of route tracking system and M/s Invendoi AI Solutions Pvt Ltd as having emerged as Rank 1 in the development of waste management surveillance system. The 55th Technical Committee meeting for the evaluation of proposals from start-ups to Government departments, chaired by the Secretary, Department of Electronics and IT, recommended the above procurement from start-ups.

Government have examined the matter in detail and are pleased to approve the recommendations of the 55th Technical Committee for the evaluation of proposals from startups to Government departments with respect to the development of Route Tracking System and Waste Management Surveillance System and to issue work order as follows:
