## ORDER

8<sup>th</sup> State Level High Powered Steering Committee (SHPSC) of AMRUT has considered 16 proposals from 16 Urban Local Bodies for revising the Administrative Sanction of Water Supply projects due to tender excess/ design change/ estimate revision. As the Central Government may not fund the tender excess amount if the contract awarded cost is more than the appraised cost and as such the tender excess amount may have to be borne by the State and respective ULB, based on the recommendation of 11<sup>th</sup> SLTC of AMRUT, as per the minutes read as 4<sup>th</sup> paper above, 8<sup>th</sup> SHPSC of AMRUT has decided to accorded sanction to revise the administrative sanction of the following 9 Water Supply projects subject to the conditions that "for 9 AMRUT 1.0 cities, 75% of the amount due to tender excess is to be met by the ULB and the balance 25% is to be met by the State. For AMRUT 2.0 cities, 50% of the amount due to tender excess is to be met by the ULB and the balance 50 % is to be met by the State. The excess amount due to the additional works shall be borne from the savings in SWAP-1 & 2"

1)"AMRUT 2.0 AWSS to Kollam Corporation - Improvements to Water Supply in Thrikkadavoor Zone - Construction Of 15 LL OHSR In Anchalumoodu Kollam Corporation Phase -I-Distribution Improvements" to Rs.7.869 Cr. (CAPEX- 7.7628, OPEX- 0.1062) due to design change and

- location change.
- 2)"AMRUT 2.0- SWAP- 2- UWSS to Kattappana Municipality Providing Functional Household Tap Connections to Households" to Rs.16.5083 Cr. (CAPEX- 14.5082 Cr., OPEX- 2 Cr.) due to 8.89% tender excess.
- 3)"AMRUT 2.0 WSS to Thalassery Municipality-Extension / Replacement of Distribution network& Providing FHTCs in Thalassery Municipality" to Rs.27.565 Cr. (CAPEX- 25.717 Cr., OPEX- 1.848) due to tender excesses (<10%) of three sub projects.</p>
- 4)"AMRUT 2.0- Providing additional pumping system, FHTCs and construction of 2LL OHSR for improving the water supply at Chanthakunnu area" of Irinjalakuda Municipality to Rs.3.464 Cr. (CAPEX- 3.31 OPEX-0.154) due to 7.5% tender excess.
- 5)"AMRUT 2.0 Improvements to AUWSS at Chalakudy Municipality General Civil Work" to Rs.13.32 Cr. (CAPEX- 12.12, OPEX- 1.20) due to 4.28% tender excess.
- 6)"AMRUT 2.0-SWAP-1 Wadakkanchery Municipality augmentation of existing WSS-replacing 250mm,150mm,100mm,80 AC pipes with 250mm DI, 160mm, 110mm, 90mm PVC pipes" to Rs.4.82 Cr. (CAPEX- 4.57, OPEX- 0.25) due to 9.43% tender excess.
- 7) "Providing house connections and distribution network in Paravoor Municipality", from Rs.13.158 Cr. to Rs.16.3201 Cr. (CAPEX: Rs.16.1692 Cr. & OPEX: Rs.0.1509) due to revision of estimate and excess in road restoration cost.
- 8)AMRUT 2.0 WSS to Payyoli Municipality in Kozhikode district to Rs.17.212 Cr. (CAPEX 16.749 Cr and OPEX 0.463 Cr) due to 9.99% tender excess.
- 9) "PHDS-Supply, Erection and Commissioning of Chlorine absorption system at 36 MLD WTP, Vellayambalam main section, Thiruvananthapuram Corporation to Rs. 0.1228 Cr (CAPEX- 0.1178, OPEX- 0.005) due to estimate revision.
- 2. As per the minutes read as 4 th paper above, the 8th SHPSC has also decided to accord in principle sanction to revise the administrative sanction for the following 5 Water Supply projects as per the recommendation from the Managing Director, KWA and subject to the above conditions.
  - Priority 2- Improving Production capacity of 100 MLD WTP Supply and fixing of VT pump sets at RWPH, Pazhoor and interconnection" in Kochi Corporation to Rs.5.00 Cr. (CAPEX -Rs 4.6 Cr, OPEX- Rs 0.40 Cr.) due to additional works.
  - "AMRUT 2.0- Augmentation of UWSS to Pala Municipality in Kottayam District" to Rs.5.633 Cr. (CAPEX- 5.333, OPEX- 0.30) due to 9.99% tender excess.
  - 3) "AMRUT 2.0 -Providing water connection and pipeline Extension in Ettumanoor Municipality" to Rs.13.1954 Cr. (CAPEX- 12.0054, OPEX-

- 1.190) due to 9.99% tender excess
- 4)"AMRUT 2.0 Water Supply Scheme to Tirurangadi Municipality (Phase-1)" to Rs.16.219 Cr. (CAPEX- 15.219 Cr., OPEX- 1 Cr.) due to 9.99% tender excess.
- 5)"AMRUT 2.0 Muvattupuzha Municipality-Renovation of Existing Water Supply Scheme UWSS to Muvattupuzha & Providing FHTC to all Households" to Rs. 7.875 Cr. (CAPEX- 7.79 Cr, OPEX- 0.0848 Cr) due to 8.87% tender excess & increase in Road restoration charges
- 3. As per the letter read as 5 <sup>th</sup> paper above, Mission Director AMRUT has requested to accord sanction for revising the administrative sanction of the 9 water supply projects as detailed above, based on the decision of 8<sup>th</sup> SHPSC.
- 4. As per the letter read as 6 th paper above, Mission Director, AMRUT has also requested to accord revised Administrative Sanction for the 5 Water Supply projects for which the SHPSC decided to accord in principle sanction to revise the administrative sanction, as the Managing Director, KWA has recommended the revision of Administrative Sanction for the said works
- Government have examined the matter and are pleased to accord revised Administrative Sanction for 14 Water Supply projects as detailed below, subject to the conditions that,
- i) for 9 AMRUT 1.0 cities, 75% of the amount due to tender excess is to be met by the ULB and the balance 25% is to be met by the State.
- ii) for AMRUT 2.0 cities, 50% of the amount due to tender excess is to be met by the ULB and the balance 50 % is to be met by the State.
- ii) the excess amount due to the additional works shall be borne from the savings in SWAP-1 & 2"
