to finalize land for Regional Sanitary Incinerator Facilities.

ORDER

As per the Government Order, read as 1st paper above, Administrative Sanction was accorded for the establishment of four Regional Sanitary Waste Incineration Facilities in the State, each with a capacity of 20 TPD, at Kottarakkara (Kollam), Moovattupuzha (Ernakulam), Kuttippuram (Malappuram) and Kadannappalli (Kannur) with the aim of filling the gap in the current decentralized Sanitary Waste Management system. The Plants, each of which are proposed to be set up in land with an extent of 50 cents, to be implemented by the Clean Kerala Company Ltd. (CKCL) under a suitable Public-Private Partnership (PPP) model.

2. Considering the difficulty in executing the project in Ernakulam, the other land options in Ernakulam District were examined in the meeting. With reference to the Brahmapuram, it was observed that Kochi corporation had prepared and approved a waste management master plan in which certain areas were earmarked for future development. It was hence noticed that 1 acre of land adjacent to the existing incinerator at Brahmapuram, Ernakulam as identified in the Master Plan, for establishing the proposed Regional Sanitary Incinerator Facility.

3. Government have examined the matter in detail and are pleased to order that:

a) Kochi Municipal Corporation shall formally set apart 1 (One) acre of land adjacent to the existing incinerator at Brahmapuram, which has already been earmarked in the Master Plan for future development, for the establishment of the Regional Sanitary Incinerator Facility.

b) While operationalizing the Regional Sanitary Incinerator Facility, preference shall be given to process the excess sanitary waste generated within the limits of Kochi Municipal Corporation .

3. The Secretary, Kochi Corporation shall take necessary steps to demarcate and transfer the land for the project, in consultation with Suchitwa Mission and Clean Kerala Company.
