ORDER

The work of Package No.KR.07-42 Yendayaar Plappally Road in Kanjirappally Block, Kottayam was completed in 2020 under Phase 8 of PMGSY-I. The minor landslip occurred in July, 2024 during the monsoon, damaged the road's embankment portion and shoulders near a culvert. Accordingly, the Executive Engineer, PIU, Kottayam prepared an estimate for the restoration of the road amounting to ₹5,11,855/- including 18% GST. The Chief Engineer, KSRRDA has, as per letter read above, requested Administrative Sanction for the aforesaid restoration estimate. The Chief Engineer has also reported that the estimate for the rectification of the road had been submitted to the District Collector and the Thahasildar of Kottayam to include in the flood relief fund and the expenditure may be met from the head of account sanctioned for the rectification of damaged roads due to flood as the NRIDA/MoRD would not provide additional fund for the purpose.

2.Government have examined the matter in detail and are pleased to accord Administrative Sanction for the restoration estimate for 'Package No. KR.07-42 Yendayaar Plappally Road' in Kanjirappally Block, Kottayam, costing ₹5,11,854/- by meeting the expenditure from the current year's budget provision for State Support for PMGSY subject to the following conditions;

(i) Cost escalation will not be admitted on any account and the overall expenditure will be within the current year's budgetary allocation.

(ii) There shall be no duplication of the work from any other source of funds and the Chief Engineer, KSRRDA should withdraw the proposal submitted to Disaster Management Department.
