### ORDER

The PMGSY work of Package No. KR-03-101, Poochapara-Devarupara road in Idukki was one of the roads affected by the heavy flood occurred in 2018. The landslide had occurred when the road was under construction and the road structures were completely destroyed in several portions by the flow of water, earth, and boulders. The road work was completed except for the flood affected portion, and therefore the Chief Engineer, KSRRDA, as per letter read above, has submitted a restoration estimate for an amount of ₹99,42,000/- including 18% GST, with minimum requirements such as CC pavement, guard work, etc, so as to open the road for traffic and requested to accord Administrative sanction for the same.

2). Government have examined the matter in detail and are pleased to accord Administrative Sanction for the restoration estimate for the flood affected portion of the work " PMGSY - Package No. KR-03-101 Poochapara- Devarupara Road in Idukki" for an amount of ₹99,42,000/- (Rupees Ninety Nine Lakh Forty Two Thousand only), subject to the compliance of the following.

(a) The recommendation of the Chief Engineer, KSRRDA for the CC retaining wall after site visit is accepted considering the change of

proposal from temporary nature to permanent. The retaining wall shall be economized before issuing Technical Sanction ensuring stability.

(b) The cut parapets proposed with CC may be reviewed and converted to Random rubble masonry. The Irish drain of 1.50m proposed on both sides shall also be reviewed and limited to the minimum width required to ensure the flow water alone.

(c) The savings obtained during review shall not be diverted for any other purpose.
