### ORDER

As per the Government order read as 1st paper above, Administrative Sanction was accorded for the implementation of the Centrally Sponsored Scheme - Component 1 (City Level Action) of the CITIIS 2.0 program in Thiruvananthapuram City for the object of "Improved & integrated Solid Waste Management in the City of Thiruvananthapuram" and Smart City Thiruvananthapuram Ltd (SCTL) was authorised as the Special Purpose Vehicle (SPV) for an implementation period of four years, adhering to the CITIIS 2.0 Component 1 Operational Guidelines. Since this scheme was notified under the SNA-SPARSH mechanism, the Ministry of Housing & Urban Affairs, GoI have released Mother sanction for an amount of Rs.7,49,47,064/- (Rupees Seven Crores Forty-Nine Lakhs Forty-Seven Thousand Sixty-Four only) as central share (80%) during the FY 2026-27, as per reference read as 2nd paper above.

2) As per letter read as third paper above, the CEO, Smart City Thiruvananthapuram Ltd has requested for the release of the Mother Sanction amount along with 20% corresponding state share and to allocate a total amount of Rs. 9,36,83,830/- (Rupees Nine Crore Thirty-Six lakhs Eighty-Three Thousand Eight-Hundred and Thirty only) to the CEO, SCTL who is designated as the DDO of the Head Of account "2217-05-191-48 (52) & (53) Plan". The CEO, SCTL has also informed that for the current financial year, an amount of Rs.39 Crore has been earmarked under the H/a 2217-05-191-48 (52) and Rs. 9.75 Crore has been earmarked under the head of account 2217-05-191-48 (53) in the state budget.

3) Government have examined the matter in detail. Under the SNA-SPARSH mechanism, release of funds is required to be effected through a single H/a corresponding to the state share, viz. H/A 2217-05-191-48 (53). Therefore, sanction is accorded for the release of an amount of Rs.9,36,83,830/- (Rupees Nine Crore Thirty-Six lakhs Eighty-Three Thousand Eight-Hundred and Thirty only) comprising both the Central Share and the matching State Share of Rs.1,87,36,766/- through the H/A 2217-05-191-48 (53), towards the first tranche of Mother Sanction received vide letter read as second paper above.

4) Sanction is also accorded to the CCO of the concerned H/A to release the amount to the CEO, SCTL who is designated as the DDO, in accordance with Circular No. 02/2025/Fin. dated 10.01.2025 and the guidelines governing the SNA-SPARSH system.

5) The CEO, SCTL shall ensure prompt utilisation of the amount sanctioned in adherence to the operational guidelines governing the CITIIS 2.0 Scheme. The utilisation certificate -and all mandatory documents shall be submitted along with the proposal for next fund release.
