### **ORDER**

Sri.Rajan, who worked as sanitation worker in Adoor Municipality filed WP(C)No.7688/2026 before Hon'ble High Court of Kerala, was a temporary substitute contingent worker in Adoor Municipality since 17.09.2002. Later his service was regularised on 14.10.2015. He filed the WP(C)No.7688/2026 claiming for inclusion in statutory pension scheme.

2.The Hon'ble High Court of Kerala, in its judgment read as 1st paper above, directed the Government to consider the representation read as 2<sup>nd</sup> paper above (Exhibit P3) submitted by Sri. A. Rajan, Sanitation Worker, Adoor Municipality, seeking inclusion in the Statutory Pension Scheme, after affording an opportunity of hearing to the petitioner and the Secretary, Adoor Municipality, and to pass appropriate orders thereon within four months.

3.In compliance with the above judgment, a personal hearing was conducted on 09.06.2026. The petitioner was selected as temporary substitute contingent worker in Adoor Municipality from the list furnished by Employment Exchange. Later as per the decision dated 01.10.2015 of the Council, he was regularised on 14.10.2015. The petitioner reiterated the

contentions raised in his representation.

4. Government examined the representation of the petitioner, the report of the Principal Director, Local Self Government Department read as 3rd paper above and the report furnished by the Secretary, Adoor Municipality read as 4th paper above and all connected records.

5. The petitioner initially worked as a temporary substitute contingent worker in Adoor Municipality from 17.09.2002. However, his service was regularised only with effect from 14.10.2015. As per the reports read as 3rd and 4th paper above, the petitioner's regular appointment in municipality commenced only on 14.10.2015, i.e., after 01.04.2013, the cut-off date prescribed for admission to the Statutory Pension Scheme.

6. Government have examined the matter in detail. Since the petitioner's regular service commenced only on 14.10.2015, after the introduction of the National Pension System, Government find no grounds to allow his request for inclusion in the Statutory Pension Scheme.

7. In the above circumstances, the Exhibit P3 request of Sri. A. Rajan, Sanitation Worker, Adoor Municipality, for inclusion in the Statutory Pension Scheme is hereby rejected.

8. Accordingly, the directions contained in the judgment dated 27.02.2026 of the Hon'ble High Court of Kerala in WP(C) No.7688/2026 stand complied with.
