ORDER

As per the Government order read as 1st paper above, Administrative Sanction was accorded for the implementation of the Centrally Sponsored Scheme - Component 2 (State Level Action) of the CITIIS 2.0 program, with an approved outlay of Rs 25.2 Cr for the object of Strengthening Climate Governance Mechanisms for Climate Action through Data-driven Planning & Capacity building in the state of Kerala, and also to authorise Smart City Thiruvananthapuram Limited (SCTL) as the execution agency for the program. As per the Tri Partite agreement executed between MoHUA, Government of Kerala and NIUA (National Institute of Urban Affairs), the approved one-time grant of Rs 25.2 Cr under Component 2 is to be disbursed in the ratio 30:40:30.

(2) Vide letter read as 2nd paper above, the Chief Executive Officer,

SCTL has informed that the Government of India have sanctioned an amount of Rs 7,52,00,000/- towards the first tranche of the approved grant and hence requested that this amount be released to the CEO SCTL, who is designated as the DDO of the concerned Head of Account. The CEO, SCTL has also informed that Rs 10.18 crore has been provided in the State Budget for the year 2026 - 27 under the Head of Account of "2217-05-191-48(61) — CITIIS 2.0 — Facilitating Climate - Oriented Reforms Action at the State Level — Component-2 — State Level Action (100% Central Share)."

(3) Government have examined the matter in detail and are pleased to accord sanction for the release of Rs 7,52,00,000/- (Rupees Seven Crore Fifty-Two Lakh only) received from the Government of India towards the 100% Centrally Sponsored Scheme (SLS Code: KL398) under the Head of Account of "2217-05-191-48(61) — CITIIS 2.0 — Facilitating Climate-Oriented Reforms Action at the State Level — Component - 2 — State Level Action (100% Central Share)" for the year 2026 - 27 and to allot this amount to the CEO, SCTL who is the DDO of the Head of Account.

(4) Sanction is also accorded to the CCO of the concerned H/A to release the amount to the CEO, SCTL who is designated as the DDO, in accordance with the guidelines governing the SNA-SPARSH system.

(5) The CEO, SCTL shall ensure prompt utilization of the amount sanctioned in adherence to the operational guidelines governing the CITIIS 2.0 scheme. The utilization certificate and all mandatory documents shall be submitted along with the proposal for next fund release.
