Local Self Government Department- PMGSY-II, 2017-18 (Batch-1) Package No.KR.14-24, Koliadi- Cherumad Road in Wayanad- Restoration estimate- Administrative Sanction- accorded – Orders issued.

ORDER

The work of Package No.KR.14-24, Koliadi- Cherumad Road in Wayanad was sanctioned under PMGSY-II, 2017-18 (Batch-1). Original AS amount of the work was ₹242.35 lakh and the Estimate & tender amount was ₹2,41,15,708/-. The work completed on 20.02.2021 and the Defect liability period was five years after construction. Later as part of the construction on Sulthan Bathery- Thaloor road, PWD had closed the main road and diverted the traffic through two nearby PMGSY roads connecting the main road and Package No. KR.14-24 was one among them. Due to diversion, traffic increased and damages were caused to the PMGSY road. For the restoration of the road, the Chief Engineer, KSRRDA , as per letter read above, has furnished an estimate for ₹64,31,214/- (Construction cost ₹ 54,50,181/- + GST(18%) ₹9,81,033/-) in DSoR 2021 and requested to accord Administrative sanction for the same.

2.Government have examined the matter in detail and are pleased to accord Administrative Sanction for the estimate for the restoration of the work, PMGSY-II, 2017-18 (Batch-1) Package No. KR.14-24 Koliadi-Cherumad Road in Wayanad for an amount of ₹64,31,214/-, (Rupees Sixty Four Lakh Thirty One Thousand Two Hundred Fourteen only) (Construction cost ₹ 54,50,181/- + GST(18%) ₹9,81,033/-) subject to the following conditions:

- i. The Chief Engineer, KSRRDA shall ensure that the works proposed in the estimate satisfy the functional requirements as envisaged.
- ii. TS authority shall ensure the correctness of the rates adopted for observed data provided in the estimates and the quality of materials during the time of execution.
- iii. The working chainages shall be ensured by the TS authority.
- iv. The TS Authority shall ensure that the retaining and side protection walls are constructed in strict conformity with Government Circular No. 87/2016/Fin dated 18.11.2016 and Circular No.64/2021/Fin dated 05.08.2021.
- v. As the measurements under Item No. 8 appear to be duplicated, Technical Sanction authority shall therefore inspect the site and verify the admissibility and correctness of the provisions in the estimate with reference to the site conditions before issuing the Technical Sanction.
- vi. As the damage to the road are reported to have occurred within the Defect Liability Period , the agreement authority shall ensure that the damages are not attributable due to the contractor's fault, in accordance with the terms and conditions of the agreement.
