## RULES

1. *Short title and commencement.*—(1) These Rules may be called the Kerala Panchayat Building (Regularisation of Unauthorised Construction) Amendment Rules, 2018.

(2) They shall be deemed to have come in to force on the 20th day of February, 2018.

2. *Amendment to the rules.*— (1) In the Kerala Panchayat Building (Regularisation of Unauthorised Construction) Rules, 2018, in rule 3, in sub-rule (1), for the figures "90", the figures "270" shall be substituted.

**Explanatory Note**

(This does not form part of the notification, but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

As per sub-rule (1) of rule 3 of the Kerala Panchayat Building (Regularisation of Unauthorised Construction) Rules, 2018 issued under G. O. (P) No. 12/2018/LSGD, dated 15th February, 2018 and published as S. R. O. No. 96/2018 in the Kerala Gazette Extraordinary No. 408 dated 20th February, 2018, the time-limit for filing the application for regularisation had been 90 days. The said time-limit expired on 20th May, 2018. Government have, therefore, decided to extend the time-limit up to 16th November, 2018, so as to provide an opportunity to those who could not file application in time.

The notification is intended to achieve the above object.
