No. 867/2018.—In exercise of the powers conferred by sections 365 and 407 of the Kerala Municipality Act, 1994 (20 of 1994) the Government of Kerala hereby make the following rules to amend the Kerala Municipality Building (Regularisation of Unauthorised Construction) Rules, 2018 issued under G. O. (P) No. 11/2018/LSGD, dated 15th February, 2018 and published as S. R. O. No. 95/2018 in the Kerala Gazette Extraordinary No. 407, dated 20th February, 2018, namely:

RULES

1. *Short title and commencement.*—(1) These Rules may be called the Kerala Municipality Building (Regularisation of Unauthorised Construction) Second Amendment Rules, 2018.

(2) They shall be deemed to have come into force on the 20th day of February, 2018.

2. *Amendment to the rules.*—In the Kerala Municipality Building (Regularisation of Unauthorised Construction) Rules, 2018, in rule 3, in sub-rule (1), for the words “two hundred and seventy”, the words “four hundred and five” shall be substituted.

Explanatory Note

(This does not form part of the notification, but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

As per sub-rule (1) of rule 3 of the Kerala Municipality Building (Regularisation of Unauthorised Construction) Rules, 2018 issued under G. O. (P) No. 11/2018/LSGD dated 15th February, 2018 and published as S. R. O. No. 95/2018 in the Kerala Gazette Extraordinary No. 407 dated 20th February, 2018, the time-limit for filing the application for regularisation had been 90 days. As per G. O. (Ms.) No. 47/2018/LSGD dated 20th June, 2018 and published as S. R. O. No. 422/2018 in the Kerala Gazette Extraordinary No. 1661 dated 22nd June, 2018, the said time limit had been extended to two hundred and seventy days. The said time limit expired on 16th November, 2018. Government have, therefore, decided to extend the time limit up to 31st March, 2019, so as to provide an opportunity to those who could not file application in time.

The notification is intended to achieve the above object.
